

- EV registration data is now available on Maryland's <u>Open</u> <u>Data Portal</u>




## Funding Opportunities for EVSE

- Maryland's <u>Alternative Fuel Infrastructure Program</u> (AFIP)
  - Grant amounts are capped at 50% of project cost, up to \$55,000 for DC Fast Charger projects.
- <u>Electric Vehicle Supply Equipment (EVSE) Rebate Program</u> 2.0
  - 40% of purchase and installation price, up to \$700 for residential installations, \$4,000 for commercial installations and \$5,000 for retail service stations.
- Maryland Volkswagen Mitigation Plan
  - 15% of the total Maryland allocated funds for EVSE (\$11.3 million)
- Electrify America
  - \$2 billion *nationwide* in electric vehicle charging infrastructure
    - Cycle 1 (\$300 million), Jan. 2017 June 2019 [Washington]
    - Cycle 2 (\$300 million), July 2019 Dec. 2021 [Washington & Baltimore]
    - Cycle 3 and 4 (\$300 million each), 30 month cycles




# Funding Opportunities for EVSE (cont.)

- Utility Electric Vehicle Portfolio (PC 44)
- Clean Corridors Act of 2019
  - Grant funding for the installation of electric vehicle charging stations and hydrogen fueling infrastructure along designated corridors
  - Funding: \$300 million for each fiscal year 2019 through 2028








# MPO Input on Future Charging Locations

- MDOT is working to compile a list of publicly-owned locations suggested for future EVSE
  - MDOT developed a preliminary list of state-owned locations for Electrify America Cycle 1
  - Currently have a list of locations from some of BMC's jurisdictions
- Online interactive outreach survey (MetroQuest) to be launched for input
